Some of these decisions are precedent-setting and carry significance for subcontractors across state lines.

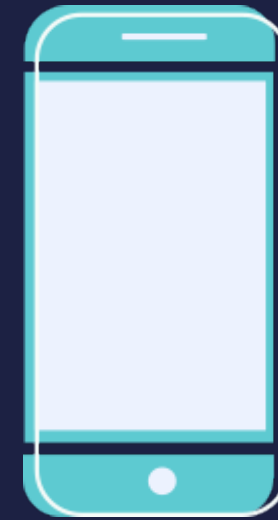
